

# Indoor Party Games for 9th Birthday

## 1. Charades

- Write down different things on paper for the kids to act out. They can use hand signals and head nods.
- The other players guess what the player doing charades is acting out.

## 2. Prize Auction

- When you send out invitations, ask each guest to bring a White Elephant gift wrapped in newspaper.
- Once guests have arrived, put the gifts on a table. Give each player \$20 in play money.
- The fun is they don't know what they are bidding on!

## 3. Balloon Relay Races

- Break guests into 2 teams. Blow up a balloon for each team.
- They have to keep the balloon between their knees from one side to the other and back.
- The balloon cannot be dropped or popped. They can only use their hands to pass it to the next player.
- First team to complete this wins.

## 4. Spin the Bottle (for gifts)

- Guests sit in a circle with the birthday gifts. The birthday girl or boy spins the bottle.
- Where the bottle lands on is the present that gets opened. Continue.

## 5. Telephone

- Guests sit in a line. The first player comes up with a phrase and whispers it to the person next to them.
- Each guest shares the phrase until the last player. The last player says the phrase outloud.

## 6. Indoor Bowling

- This game is best played on a carpet-free floor. Use empty plastic bottles as pins.
- For the bowling ball, use an inflatable beach ball or wrapping paper made into a tight ball.

## 7. What's Missing

- Put random items on a table in full view for all the players to see. Give them one minute to look.
- Ask the players to turn around while you remove an item from the table.
- The first player to guess the item missing goes to the winner's circle. Continue.

## 8. Crazy Cupcake Decorating Challenge

- Bake a bunch of plain cupcakes. Setup an area with plastic as this will get messy!
- Set out sprinkles, frosting, etc. for each child. They have 1 minute to create their cupcake.
- The fun is that they have to use their hands to create it!

## 9. Indoor Ring Toss

- Use a paper towel to create the dowel and paper plates with the middle cut out as rings.

## 10. Fun with Marshmallows

- This is a marshmallow basketball game. Use a small plastic cup for the hoop. Shoot marshmallows into it!
